COMMODITY RATING

How do I calculate commodity rates?
Here is the Motorcycle Rate (160%) as an example:

General Rate X 1.6 (160%) = Commodity Rate

DIMENSIONAL FREIGHT

Dimensional weight, also known as volumetric weight, allows us to estimate weight that is calculated from the length, width and height of bulky freight.

How do I calculate dimensional weight?
Follow this formula:

L" x W" x H" ÷ 194 = Dimensional weight.

Example: (48" x 48" x 40" ÷ 194 = 475 Pounds)

We use the actual weight or dimensional weight, whichever is higher.

MOST COMMONLY DIMENSIONALIZED FREIGHT

Coolers, Vending Machines, TVs over 55", Doors (Framed-uncrated), Windows, (Framed-uncrated), Tubs, and other oversized items.

This is not an all-inclusive list, other items may apply.
